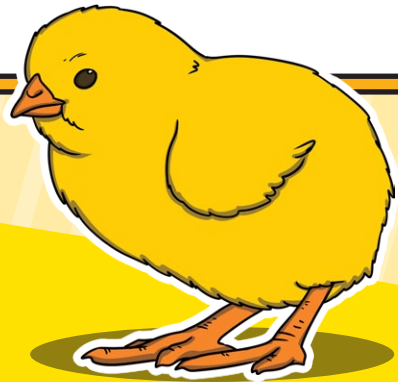


An Egg-Citing Morning

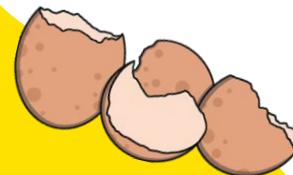

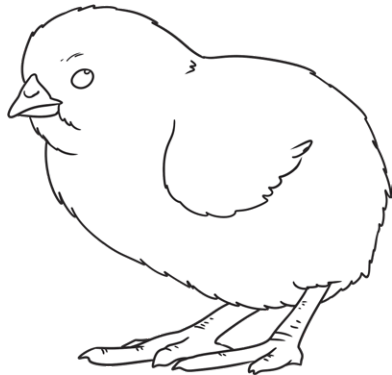
